There is also a biography center that provides information on important people, a collection of research tools such as a time line builder, individual research accounts that allow users to save their articles and content, and a research wizard that provides information about how to do a research assignment.

Edinburgh, Treaty of, ended the civil war in Scotland between Scottish Protestants and Scottish Roman Catholics backed by France.

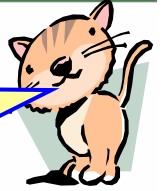
