

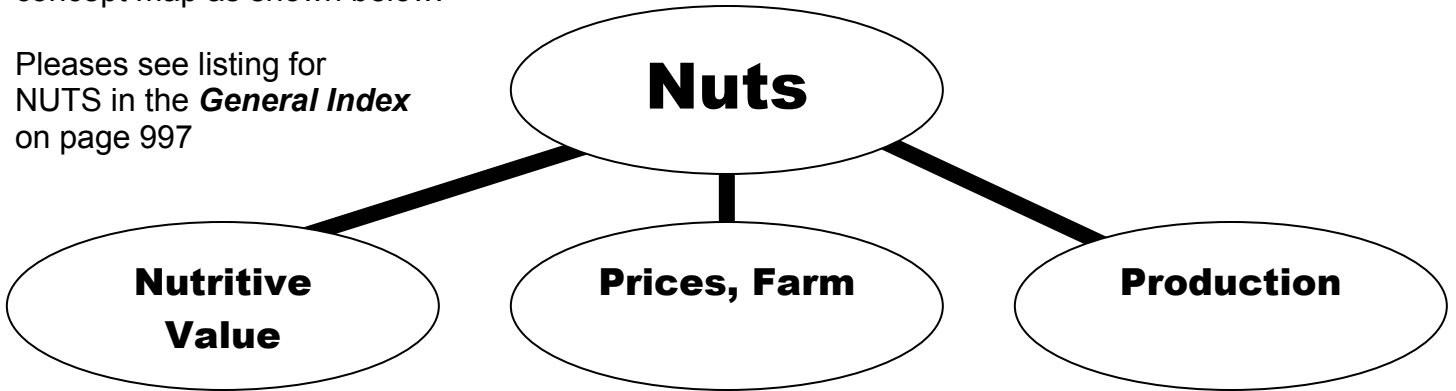
Name: _____ Using the General Index

Make Connections

The GENERAL INDEX is organized by KEYWORDS that identify the main topics in the almanac. These keywords are listed in bold, in alphabetical order. Each keyword listing is followed by the page number where that section starts.

Often, the information about a keyword is listed with SUBHEADINGS that break the main topic down into smaller units. This helps us find more specific information quickly. Below some keywords (which are listed in bold) are subheadings which are indented below the keyword in alphabetic order. Think of the keyword as the main idea and the subheadings as related ideas. We can illustrate this with a concept map as shown below:
